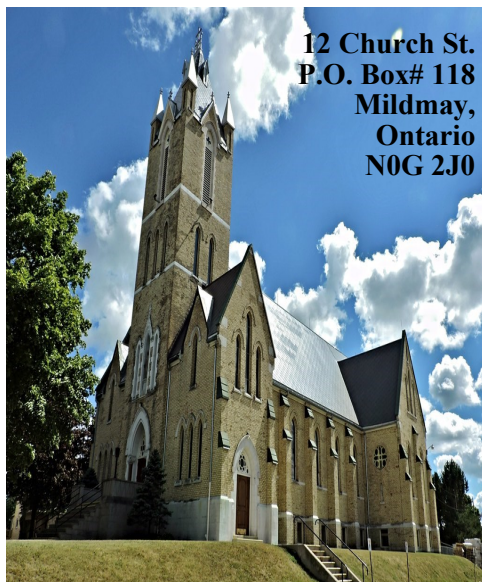

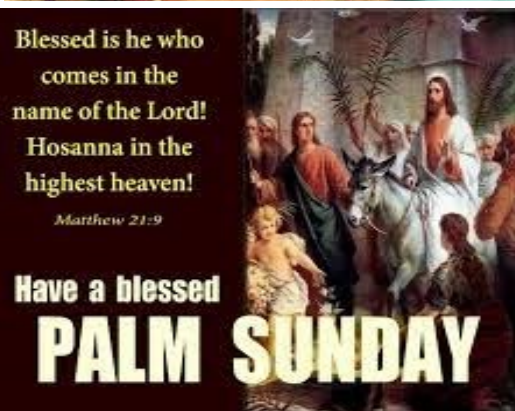

Gift to the Church

3. **CONTINGENCY BEQUEST:** Helps you leave a portion of your estate to Sacred Heart Parish if a named beneficiary does not survive you.

The Easter Triduum which begins with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday, reaching its high point in the Easter Vigil, and closes with Evening Prayer on Easter Sunday, is the summit of the Liturgical Year. It commemorates Christ's Paschal Mystery, **The PASSION, DEATH and RESURRECTION** of Jesus.

March month of St Joseph

The month of March is dedicated to Joseph. The entire month falls during the liturgical season of **Lent** which is represented by the liturgical color purple—a symbol of penance, mortification and the sorrow of a contrite heart.

As we continue our journey "up to Jerusalem" during the month of March, three prominent ideas are proposed for our contemplation by the liturgy of Lent: The Passion and Resurrection of Christ, baptism, and penance.

The **Solemnity of St. Joseph** is a special landmark this month in which we will celebrate the great honor bestowed upon the foster father of Jesus. And if you are Irish (who is not), **St. Patrick's feast** is another cause for a joyful celebration. The feast of the **Annunciation** is celebrated on March 25.

As the weeks of Lent progress let us not tire of doing our good works and penance but continue with the enthusiasm of the catechumens on their way to Easter and Baptism. May our Lenten observance be a joyful journey-and not a forced march.

**Sacred Heart Walkerton
Catholic Women's League—100th Anniversary**

In 1947, membership increased to 244.
We purchased a radio for the Royal Canadian Legion (\$32.95).
By March 1949, new constitution and Bylaw Books were printed.
We hosted a 2 day Diocesan Convention, with the C.Y.O. (Catholic Youth Organization) preparing and serving lunch on Sunday. Convention registration was .50 cents (no charge for our members).
Originally, local councils were called subdivisions.
In 1950, rubber tiling was purchased for the hall (approx. \$2000.00).
Our annual Strawberry Supper took place with the cost being .75 cents for adults and .40 cents for children.
