The month of April is dedicated to The Holy Spirit. April falls during the Easter season which is represented by the liturgical color white — the color of light, a symbol of joy, purity and innocence (absolute or restored).

Sacred Heart Walkerton CWL 100th Anniversary

In 1954, a Bazaar was held with tickets selling for \$.10 or 3/\$.25 on a bushel of apples. Chickens and a duck were donated for BINGO prizes -\$.10 per game or 3 /\$.25, coffee \$.10, sandwiches \$.15, hot dogs \$.15. In 1955, a medal (cost \$5.00) was donated to Sacred Heart High School for graduation. In 1956, Girl Guides requested purchase of a company flag for which they sold homemade cookies and candies with CWL paying the balance of the cost. Donations to the Parish were \$75.00 for vestments, \$497.35 from grand draw proceeds, and \$1,150.00 for basement renovations. In 1957, members donated food for a supper to celebrate reopening of the new parish hall—\$1.25 adults \$.60 children under 12 and 25 card tables were purchased for the hall.
