





Gift to the Church

The month of **November** is dedicated to the **Souls in Purgatory**, whose feast is celebrated on November 2.

During November, as in all of Ordinary Time (Time After Pentecost), the Liturgy signifies and expresses the regenerated life from the coming of the Holy Spirit, which is to be spent on the model of Christ's Life and under the direction of His Spirit. As we come to the end of the Church year, we are asked to consider the end times, our own as well as the world's. The culmination of the liturgical year is the Feast of Christ the King.

"This feast asserts the supreme authority of Christ over human beings and their institutions.... Beyond it we see Advent dawning with its perspective of the Lord's coming in glory."

This feast is a public, social, and official declaration of the royal rights of Jesus, as God the Creator, as The Word Incarnate, and as Redeemer.
