Gift to the Church

Leaving a gift to the Church in your Will is a profound way to return to the Lord a share of the blessings you received during your life. In 1947, membership increased to 244.

We purchased a radio for the Royal Canadian Legion (\$32.95). By March 1949, new constitution and Bylaw Books were printed. We hosted a 2 day Diocesan Convention, with the C.Y.O. (Catholic Youth Organization) preparing and serving lunch on Sunday. Convention registration was .50 cents (no charge for our members). Originally, local councils were called subdivisions. In 1950, rubber tiling was purchased for the hall (approx. \$2000.00). Our annual Strawberry Supper took place with the cost being .75 cents for adults and .40 cents for children.

APRIL IS DEVOTED TO THE HOLY SPIRIT



The month of April is dedicated to **The Holy Spirit**. April falls during the **Easter** season which is represented by the liturgical color white — the color of light, a symbol of joy, purity and innocence (absolute or restored).

April boasts the most solemn and sublime event of human history:

The Resurrection of Jesus Christ – the Paschal mystery. Though the way to the Resurrection was the *Via Crucis*, the Sacrificial Lamb of God is now and forever Christ our Light, the Eternal high priest of the New Covenant. And his sorrowful mother, the *Stabat Mater* of Good Friday, is now the jubilant Mother of the *Regina Caeli*.

We the members of Christ’s Mystical Body exalt in the mystery by which we were redeemed. If in Baptism we were buried with Christ, so also will we share in his resurrection. By his death we were reborn; “by his stripes we were healed.” (Is 53:5) Easter, the epicenter of time, is the event that links time and eternity. It is indeed “the day the Lord has made; let us be glad and rejoice in it.” (Ps 118:24)
