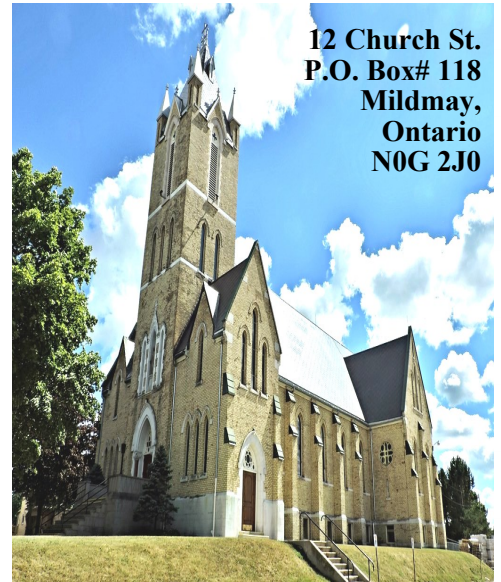

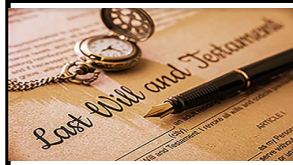

### Gift to the Church

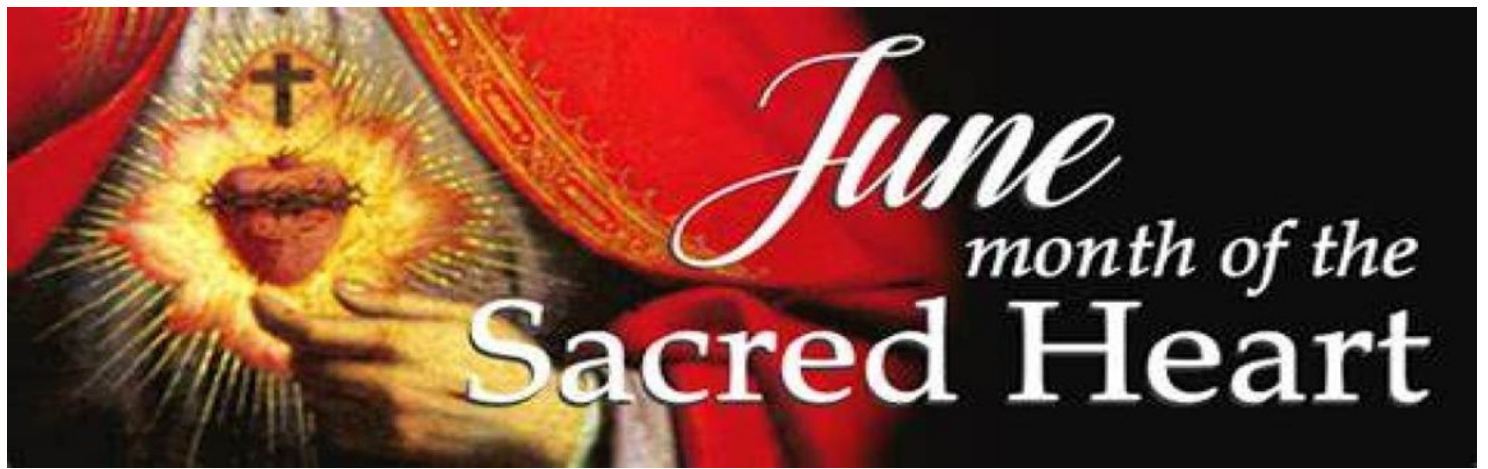

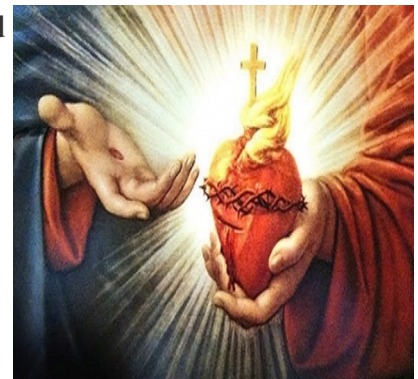
